As the President of Indonesia, Joko Widodo said at last year's Climate Change Conference COP26 in Glasgow, Indonesia has the ambition to accelerate the energy transition and to achieve net zero emissions by 2060.

However, energy transition is not only about replacing one energy source with the other. This process should also aim to maintain the accessibility to energy for the people, especially in remote areas. In addition, the sustainability of renewable energy projects in remote areas also need to be taken into consideration and the projects should not be abandoned after it has been built.

Indonesia has a target to have 23% of its energy mix coming from renewable sources by 2025, and the country needs at least Rp 1,600 trillion (US\$102.4 billion) to make that happen.

This is not an easy task, especially for medium and small-scale projects. Renewable energy projects require huge investments and this high cost makes small projects unattractive and therefore not bankable. As a result, they have to rely on grants and government budgets.

To meet its energy mix target, Indonesia has to look elsewhere for funding.





Events in Energy Sector

Focus Group Discussion (FGD) "Indonesia's Diplomatic Strategy to Support Low Carbon Development: Energy Transition and Carbon Policy"



On 6 October 2022, the Ministry of Foreign Affairs along with LPEM FEB Universitas Indonesia (UI) held an FGD: "Indonesia's Diplomatic Strategy to Support Low Carbon Development: Energy Transition and Carbon Policy". This FGD aims to find diplomacy strategies that may be implemented within the framework of ASEAN cooperation and synergy with stakeholders, including the private sector and international/regional organisations. PYC was one of the

participants in this FGD. The event was also attended by Yayan Mulyana, Head of the Foreign Policy Strategy Agency; and Riatu Mariatul Qibthiyyah, Director of LPEM FEB UI. The speakers for the discussion were Rio Budi Rahmanto, Head of the Multilateral Policy Strategy Center; Wiluyo Kusdwiharto, Director of Project Management and EBT of PT PLN (Persero); and Kardiman, Indonesian Renewable Energy Society (METI).

The Ensight "Green Human Capital: Mempersiapkan Milenial dan Gen Z untuk Transisi Energi yang Berkeadilan"

The Ensight was held once again on 15 October 2022. For its second installment, PYC invited Khoiria Oktaviani, the Program Manager of Gerakan Inisiatif Listrik Tenaga Surya (Gerilya), Kampus Merdeka, Ministry of Energy and Mineral Resources (MEMR) Republic of Indonesia; I Made Aditya Suryawidya, Secretary General Asosiasi Energi Surya Indonesia (AESI); and Anisa Isabella Agustina, Business Development of PT Sumber Energi Surya Nusantara (SESNA). The discussion was moderated by Michael Suryaprawira, a PYC researcher.



To start the main discussion of the seminar, Filda C. Yusgiantoro, Chairperson of PYC gave an opening speech. Khoiria emphasized that the MEMR has conducted a few programs to support energy transition for Gen Z in her presentation. Meanwhile, Anisa mentioned the importance of academics' role in preparing human resources in the energy sector. And lastly, I Made Aditya explained the perspective of the industry sector. Many factors, such as technology, funding, and human resources, must be considered. To close the discussion, Inka Yusgiantoro, Head of the Supervisory Board of PYC, mentioned that the younger generation needs to map out the necessary skills to support energy transition and determine which energy sources have significant potential in Indonesia.

FGD: Utilizing Solar PV for Peer-to-Peer Electricity Trading



On 22 and 27 October 2022, PYC Team held online and offline Focus Group Discussion (FGD) with the employees of PT Kariangau Power, Balikpapan and at Gumelar District Office, Banyumas, Central Java respectively. This FGD is a part of a pilot project conducted by PYC to develop a peer-to-peer electricity trading environment using a Solar PV Panel system in a microgrid. PYC Team introduced the concept of microgrids and the solar PV Panel system to the locals hoping to educate them about the project and energy sustainability in general.

The event was a success and a lot of people joined the discussion. The government officials of Central Java also attended the event and showed their support for this project. This pilot project is highly anticipated by the people and PYC will start the construction of the Solar PV System in early 2023.



PYC's Collaboration with Economic Research Institute for ASEAN and East Asia (ERIA)



For the last three months, PYC has been conducting a study on the energy transition in the manufacturing industry sector in collaboration with the Fiscal Policy Agency (BKF) and the Economic Research Institute for ASEAN and East Asia (ERIA).

Currently, almost all energy transition studies are still centered on the power generation sector. Meanwhile, the industrial sector, one of the sectors with the highest level of energy

consumption in Indonesia, has not received attention. Moreover, more and tighter global export-import policies have also caused the industrial sector to come under pressure in providing clean energy for their production processes. Therefore, this study is expected to be a driving force for the government, the industrial sector, and the academia to be able to start coordinating and working together to implement the energy transition in the manufacturing industry sector.

FGD by PYC: "Analisis Dampak Realisasi PMA Sektor Energi dan Agrikultur-Kehutanan terhadap Bidang Ekonomi Wilayah, Kondisi Sosial, Emisi Gas Rumah Kaca, dan Kualitas Lingkungan Hidup"

On Tuesday, 29 November 2022, PYC held a Focus Group Discussion (FGD) with Institut Pertanian Bogor (IPB) with the theme "Analisis Dampak Realisasi PMA Sektor Energi dan Agrikultur-Kehutanan terhadap Bidang Ekonomi Wilayah, Kondisi Sosial, Emisi Gas Rumah Kaca, dan Kualitas Lingkungan Hidup". In this FGD, PYC team and IPB team presented the results of the report and the FGD continued with a discussion session with several experts.



This discussion was also attended by Filda C. Yusgiantoro, Chairperson of PYC; Prof. Arief Sabdo Yuwono, Professor of Environmental Engineering IPB; Gigih Udi Atmo, Coordinator of Electricity Business Setup, Ministry of Energy and Mineral Resources; Yanuar Fajari, Head of Energy Sector Sub Directorate, Ministry of Investment/BKPM; Irfan Yananto, Functional Director for Environment, Ministry of National Development Planning/Bappenas; and Zainuddin, Functional Policy Analyst for Management of Forest Products and Environmental Services, Coordinating Ministry for Maritime Affairs and Investment.

CGEI Webinar - *Menuju Indonesia Bebas Emisi dengan Pemanfaatan Sumber Energi Listrik*

What is the status of the utilization of electrical energy sources to achieve Net-Zero Emissions? What efforts have been implemented?



On 29 November 2022, the Chairperson of PYC, Filda C. Yusgiantoro, presented her material titled "Status dan Upaya Konkret Pemanfaatan Sumber Energi Listrik untuk Mencapai NZE" in the webinar "Menuju Indonesia Bebas Emisi dengan Pemanfaatan Sumber Energi Listrik". This webinar was held online by Chakra Giri Energi Indonesia via Zoom Meeting. The webinar was opened by Bambang Sriyono, Principal Consultant of Chakra Giri Energi Indonesia; and Sarjiya, Head of the Center for Energy Studies (PSE) Universitas Gadjah Mada, who was also one of the speakers.

PYC in Monash Global Immersion Guarantee



Purnomo Yusgiantoro Center was one of the partners for Monash University in collaboration with The Australian Consortium for 'In-Country' Indonesian Studies (ACICIS). On 30 November 2022, PYC organized a mini-seminar and workshop as part of the Monash Global Immersion Guarantee in BSD. The event aimed to facilitate and encourage the students' awareness of energy-related global issues. The workshop was meant to be the place for students with diverse background to come together and discuss current energy issues to get a broader perspective on the opportunities and challenges of future energy development. In this event, PYC took the theme of *"Take a closer look: Energy Transition"*.

This theme is chosen due to the importance of future generations understanding and being aware of energy transition from early on. Energy security is a strategic national and international issue that must be carefully handled due to its significant impact on the national development path. It means each country must identify its potential energy source and evaluate its capability to meet future energy demands.

Furthermore, awareness of the energy transition issue must be stimulated within the young generation. A diverse perspective from policy, investment, and technology innovation will lead to how the issue should be addressed and which options should be considered. The workshop will be a suitable event to share thoughts, solidify comprehension, and envisage the future of the global energy sector in achieving sustainable energy.



The workshop's objectives are to provide a platform to increase students' awareness of energy-related issues, address energy transition issues from a multitude of perspectives, and identify the options that can be considered for the global energy sector in the future.

In the workshop, Massita Ayu Cindy, I Dewa Made Raditya Margenta, Akhmad Hanan, Vivi Fitriyanti, Felicia Grace, Michael Suryaprawira, Mayora Bunga Swastika, Vivid Amalia Khusna, Patricia Leonita, Helena Sihaloho, Galih Panuntun, Pingkan Serafien, Akhmad Munawir Siregar, Muhammad Salman Hakim were appointed as facilitators for the students. In this program, the students successfully identified the challenge, opportunities and recommendations for global energy transitions.



Australia-Indonesia Energy Transition Policy Dialogue



On 6 December 2022, Purnomo Yusgiantoro Center (PYC) hosted the Australia-Indonesia Energy Transition Policy Dialogue. PYC's founder, Prof. Purnomo Yusgiantoro and the chairperson, Filda C. Yusgiantoro also participated in the dialogue.

This event was conducted by the Centre for Policy Development (CPD) in partnership with Climateworks Centre Australia. The dialogue was conducted in hybrid; live in Indonesia and Canberra; and attended by representatives from several policymakers, regulators, businesses and non-government experts from Australia. Indonesian government and councils, departments, enterprises, and non-governmental organizations related to the energy transition also joined in the dialogue as well.

The dialogue aimed to gain insight, gather ideas, and build collaboration to develop practical, workable solutions for the energy challenges faced by Australia and Indonesia. As for the topics discussed were infrastructure and just energy transition followed by governance and financing.




